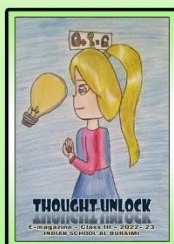
Paulo Coelho has said "When we strive to become better than we are, everything around us becomes better too."

APJ Abdul Kalam was a great Indian aerospace scientist, politician, teacher and writer. His full name was Avul Pakir Jainulabdeen Abdul Kalam. He is also known as the 'Missile Man'. He was born on 15th October, 1931 in Rameswaram, Tamil Nadu. His father's name was Jainulabdeen who was a boat owner. His mother's name was Ashiamma and she was a housewife. He was born in very poor family. He was a very hardworking student since childhood. He did his Aeronautical Engineering at Madras Engineering College. He worked as a scientist at DRDO and ISRO. He was the 11th President of India, serving from 2002-2007. In his life he wrote a number of books. He was awarded the 'Bharat Ratna' in 1997. He died on 27th July 2015 while delivering a lecture to students at Indian Institute of Management, Shillong. India reacted to Kalam's death with an outpouring of grief. He inspired millions of young people to achieve their best. Dr. Kalam's humility and dedication to public service served as an inspiration to millions of Indians and is admired around the world.

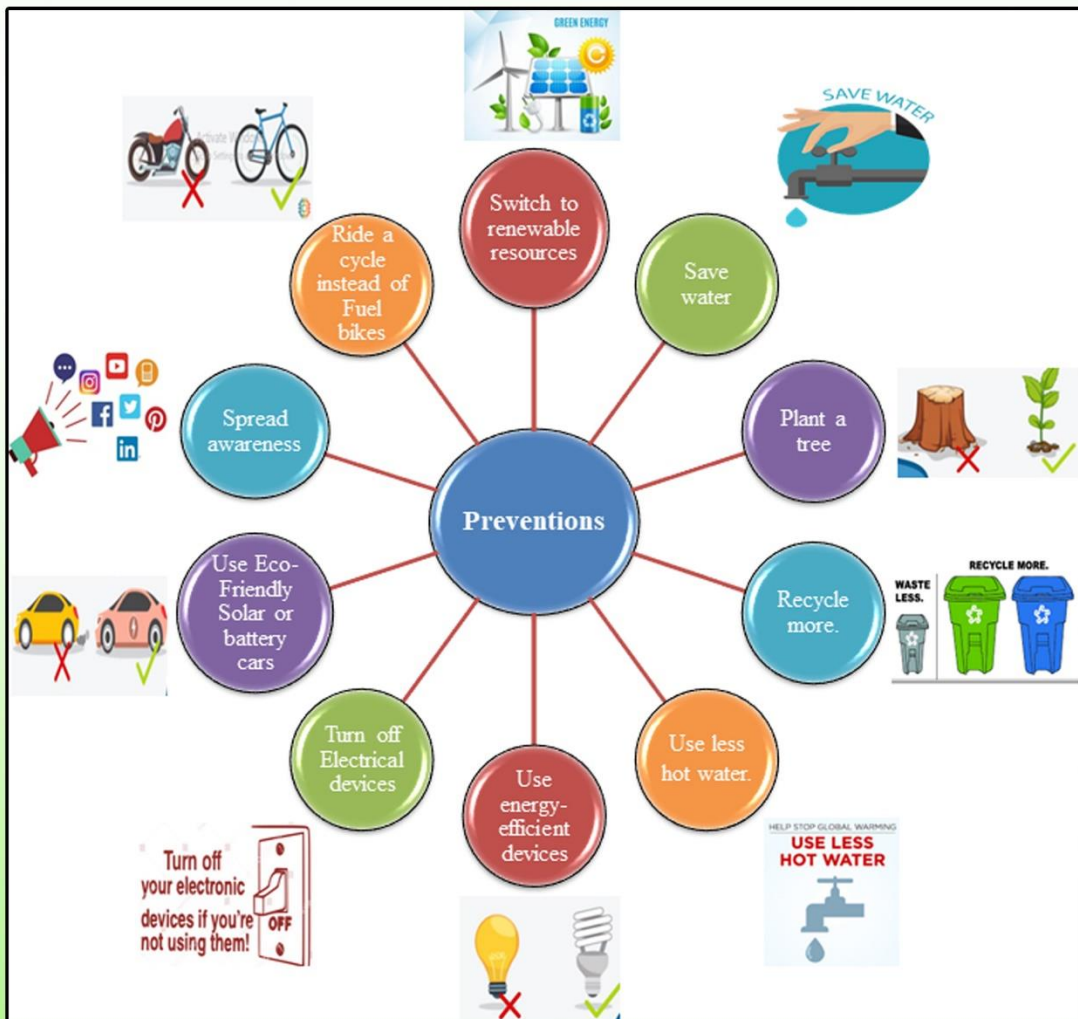
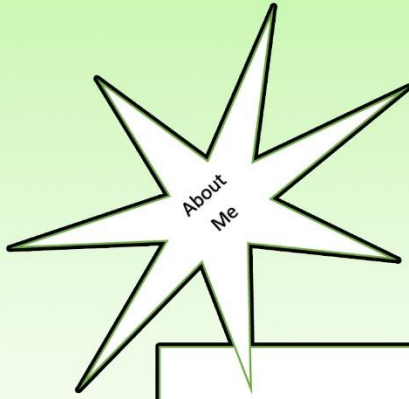

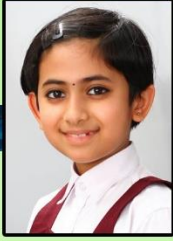

Mars is the fourth planet from the Sun - a dusty, cold, desert world with a very thin atmosphere made of carbon dioxide, nitrogen and argon. Mars is also a dynamic planet with seasons, polar ice caps, canyons, extinct volcanoes, and evidence that it was even more active in the past. It is the second smallest planet in the solar system being larger than Mercury. Mars is named after the Roman God of war due to its redness. According to NASA, it takes two and a half years to travel from Earth to Mars. Galileo first observed this planet through a telescope in 1609. Mars has 687 days in a year. It has been confirmed by NASA that a small colony will be established on Mars by 2030. Mars is about half the size of Earth. Mars is the second planet in the solar system to have the presence of water. Mars is the planet that is most similar to Earth in the Solar System. Evidence suggests that Mars was once full of water, warmer and had a thicker atmosphere, offering a potentially habitable environment.
